New to IMC? Welcome! Last year we had many children discovering the enjoyment of playing a musical instrument and they gave delightful spring recitals online! We have a wonderful team of educated and motivated instructors to share the love of music with your child. They each undergo background checks and have demonstrated teaching experience.

My name is Ryan and I look forward to meeting you. I hold a masters degree in music and have been teaching music for over 20 years. I perform, too, and miss those opportunities playing with others. May this still be an enriching, positive year for our children and may music assist in their joys and expression.

TUITION: Music tuition is billed by e-mail in advance each month (except for the first monthly payment which is due with the registration form) over a nine-month period, October to June. Tuition rates are:

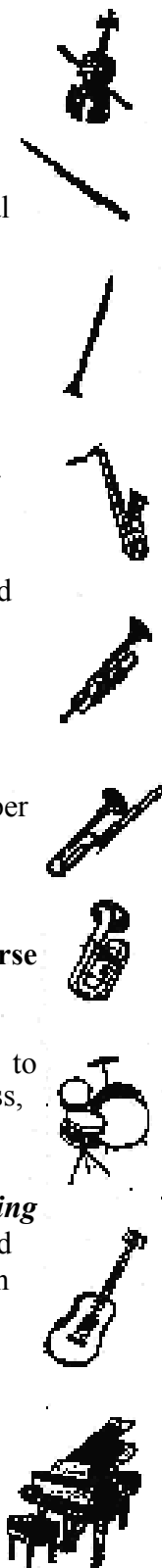
\$139 per month for 30-minute private lessons
\$208 per month for 45-minute private lessons

There are 9 installment-type payments, and each student receives 29 lessons in the course of the school year. Any music books your child may need will be billed as a separate item.

INSTRUMENTS: Piano students must have a piano or appropriate keyboard on which to practice. Renting an instrument from a local music store is a great option for many string, brass, and woodwind students.

REGISTRATION: Please mail or e-mail registration form to the address below. ***Continuing students must once again submit a registration form.*** The program runs all school year and you will only need to sign up once per year. You will be notified regarding your child's lesson day and time, and the school-year session will kick off late September. We are looking forward to working with your child!

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSON REGISTRATION AND AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, am the parent of a child who wishes to enroll in the Instrumental Music Program (“Program”) offered through Instrumental Music for Children, Inc. (“IMC”). This document is an agreement (“Agreement”) between myself and IMC.

IMC agrees to provide independent contractor/teachers who will provide instrumental music lessons to my child. I understand that IMC is agreeing only to provide qualified music teachers who will provide music lessons to my child as stated below. I agree to hold IMC, together with its agents, managers, and employees, harmless from any claim which does not arise from its duty to provide independent contractor/teachers who are qualified to give instrumental music lessons under this Agreement.

I understand that by signing this Agreement I am enrolling my child(ren) in the music Program for a full semester. I agree to pay IMC according to the following schedule: Music tuition is billed in 9 equal monthly amounts (4 payments the first semester, 5 payments the second semester) over the course of the school year and is due on the first of the month (unless other arrangements have been made). A late fee of \$5.00 will be charged for payments not received by the tenth of the month.

Each student receives 29 lessons (one of which is the recital rehearsal) in the course of the school year. Private students are allowed one excused absence per semester. In order to qualify for the one excused absence for a private lesson for the semester, I understand that I must call the child’s music teacher at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled lesson to cancel the lesson. If my child cannot make an afternoon lesson on a minimum day, I acknowledge that I must notify the teacher 24 hours in advance in order to avoid having the lesson counted as an unexcused absence.

If my child continues in the Program in the second semester, I understand and agree that the same policies stated above apply.
