Hi Families!

The St. Perpetua Instrumental Music Program is going into its 28th successful year of teaching music lessons. Last year we had many children discovering the enjoyment of playing a musical instrument, and they gave delightful and entertaining performances during the school year. We are extremely proud of their fine accomplishments, and we are looking forward to another wonderful year for our young musicians!

Lessons are offered for: Piano • Guitar • Bass • Drums • Brass • Woodwinds • Strings

LESSONS: Private lessons are offered throughout the school year in your home or online. Lessons continue during the summer for those who wish and there is a separate sign-up for that at the end of the school year.

MUSIC TUITION: Music tuition is billed by e-mail in advance each month (except for the first monthly payment which is due with the registration form) over a nine-month period, October to June. Tuition is as follows:

\$141 per month for 30-minute private lessons \$210 per month for 45-minute private lessons

There are 9 installment-type payments, and each student receives 29 lessons in the course of the school year. Any music books your child may need will be billed as a separate item.

INSTRUMENTS: Piano students must have a piano or appropriate keyboard on which to practice. Renting an instrument from a local music store is a great option for many string, brass, and woodwind students.

REGISTRATION: Please mail or e-mail registration form to the address below. *Continuing students must once again submit a registration form.* The program runs all school year and you will only need to sign up once per year. You will be notified regarding your child's lesson day and time, and the school-year session will kick off late September. We are looking forward to working with your child!

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSON REGISTRATION AND AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, am the parent of a child who wishes to enroll in the Instrumental Music Program ("Program") offered through Instrumental Music for Children, Inc. ("IMC"). This document is an agreement ("Agreement") between myself and IMC.

IMC agrees to provide independent contractor/teachers who will provide instrumental music lessons to my child. I understand that IMC is agreeing only to provide qualified music teachers who will provide music lessons to my child as stated below. I agree to hold IMC, together with its agents, managers, and employees, harmless from any claim which does not arise from its duty to provide independent contractor/teachers who are qualified to give instrumental music lessons under this Agreement. The instrumental music teachers are not employees of St. Perpetua School.

I understand that by signing this Agreement I am enrolling my child(ren) in the music Program for a full semester. I agree to pay IMC according to the following schedule: Music tuition is billed in 9 equal monthly amounts (4 payments the first semester, 5 payments the second semester) over the course of the school year and is due on the first of the month (unless other arrangements have been made). A late fee of \$5.00 will be charged for payments not received by the tenth of the month.

Each student receives 29 lessons (one of which is the recital rehearsal) in the course of the school year. Private students are allowed one excused absence per semester. In order to qualify for the one excused absence for a private lesson for the semester, I understand that I must call the child's music teacher at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled lesson to cancel the lesson. If my child cannot make an afternoon lesson on a minimum day, I acknowledge that I must notify the teacher 24 hours in advance in order to avoid having the lesson counted as an unexcused absence

If my child continues in the Program in the second semester, I understand and agree that the same policies stated above apply.
