Dear Parents:

The St. Agnes Band and Strings Program is going into its 2nd successful year and we are extremely proud of the accomplishments of our young musicians! Last year our students made great progress and gave delightful performances in the spring! We are looking forward to another great year!

CLASSES: Classes are open to students in grades 4-8. Please see class schedules below. **Band Classes** will consist of flute, clarinet, alto sax, trumpet, trombone, and baritone. **Strings Classes** will include violin, viola and cello. There will be 27 class meetings in the course of the school year. (Note: The Friday classes will meet at 12:05 and 12:50 on 10/14 and 5/26.)

RECITAL: Classes will perform in a recital in the spring. The recitals are always delightful!

TUITION: Music tuition is billed in advance each month (except for the first monthly payment which is due with the registration form. The tuition is paid in equal monthly installments of \$57 over a nine-month period, October to June. The music books will be billed as a separate item. Checks for all tuition and materials fees can be made payable to "IMC." You also have the option to pay by credit/debit card (see registration form).

INSTRUMENTS: Students will need to provide their own instrument to use. Many brass, woodwind and string students choose to rent an instrument. Renting a string instrument requires that you take your child with you to the music store so as to obtain the correct instrument size. Rockin' Robbie's East Bay Music on Colfax St. and C&L Music on Monument Blvd. are excellent stores for the rental of instruments.

REGISTRATION: We would like to have all registration forms as soon as possible so that we may begin to make appropriate arrangements for each group. Classes will begin September 29th and 30th. We are looking forward to working with your child!

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSON REGISTRATION AND AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, am the parent of a child who wishes to enroll in the Instrumental Music Program (“Program”) offered through Instrumental Music for Children, Inc. (“IMC”). This document is an agreement (“Agreement”) between myself and IMC.

IMC agrees to provide independent contractor/teachers who will provide instrumental music instruction to my child. I understand that IMC is agreeing only to provide qualified music teachers who will provide music instruction to my child as stated below. I agree to hold IMC, together with its agents, managers, and employees, harmless from any claim which does not arise from its duty to provide independent contractor/teachers who are qualified to give instrumental music instruction under this Agreement.

I understand that by signing this Agreement I am enrolling my child(ren) in the music Program for a full semester. I agree to pay IMC according to the following schedule: Music tuition is billed in 9 equal monthly amounts (4 payments the first semester, 5 payments the second semester) over the course of the school year and is due on the first of the month (unless other arrangements have been made). A late fee of \$5.00 will be charged for payments not received by the tenth of the month.

Each class receives 27 lessons in the course of the school year. Due to the progressive nature of the class, I understand that students may not drop out and then return to classes during the course of the school year. I acknowledge that missed classes cannot be made up or refunded. In order to withdraw my child from the music Program, I understand that I must provide a two-week, advance written notice to IMC and that tuition will be assessed through the notice period whether or not the classes are taken.

Please send this form along with your first monthly payment of \$57 to IMC, P.O. Box 1934, Benicia, CA 94510, or you may return the form by e-mail. **Make checks payable to IMC. A registration form that is not accompanied by the first payment will be assessed the late fee for the first month, unless payments will be made by credit card.**

If my child continues in the Program in the second semester, I understand and agree that the same policies stated above apply.
