Hello Families!

The Instrumental Music Program is going into its 27th successful year of offering after-school music lessons and we are extremely proud of the accomplishments of our young musicians! Last year we had many children learning the joy of playing a musical instrument. They made great progress and gave a delightful and entertaining recital in the spring. We are looking forward to another great year!

**LESSONS:** Music lessons take place on a weekly basis. Because the schedule for lessons at school is typically quite full, we also offer lessons online or in your home.

**MUSIC TUITION:** Music tuition is billed each month. Students receive 29 lessons in the course of the school year and there are 9 tuition installments, October to June. Any music books your child may need will be billed as a separate item. Tuition is as follows:

Lessons at SchoolLessons at Home/Online\$128 per month for 30-minute private lessons\$141 per month for 30-minute private lessons\$210 per month for 45-minute private lessons

**INSTRUMENTS:** Piano students must have a piano or appropriate keyboard on which to practice. For renting a guitar it is recommended that you take your child with you to the music store in order to obtain the correct instrument size.

**REGISTRATION:** Please mail or e-mail registration form to the address below. *Continuing students must once again submit a registration form.* The Music Program runs all school year and you will only need to sign up once per year. Lessons will kick off in late September but students may join at any time, availability permitting. We are looking forward to working with your child!

## INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSON REGISTRATION AND AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, am the parent of a child who wishes to enroll in the Instrumental Music Program ("Program") offered through Instrumental Music for Children, Inc. ("IMC"). This document is an agreement ("Agreement") between myself and IMC.

IMC agrees to provide independent contractor/teachers who will provide instrumental music lessons to my child. I understand that IMC is agreeing only to provide qualified music teachers who will provide music lessons to my child as stated below. I agree to hold IMC, together with its agents, managers, and employees, harmless from any claim which does not arise from its duty to provide independent contractor/teachers who are qualified to give instrumental music lessons under this Agreement.

I understand that by signing this Agreement I am enrolling my child(ren) in the music Program for a full semester. I agree to pay IMC according to the following schedule: Music tuition is billed in 9 equal monthly amounts (4 payments the first semester, 5 payments the second semester) over the course of the school year and is due on the first of the month (unless other arrangements have been made). A late fee of \$5.00 will be charged for payments not received by the twelfth of the month.

Each student receives 29 lessons (one of which is the recital rehearsal) in the course of the school year. Private students are allowed one excused absence per semester. In order to qualify for the one excused absence for a private lesson for the semester, I understand that I must call the child's music teacher at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled lesson to cancel the lesson. If my child cannot make an afternoon lesson on a minimum day, I acknowledge that I must notify the teacher 24 hours in advance in order to avoid having the lesson counted as an unexcused absence.

If my child continues in the Program in the second semester, I understand and agree that the same policies stated above apply.
